Fort McCoy: Once a year, the Fort McCoy military installation is open for <u>public viewing</u> to pay tribute to & show support for service members in all branches of our Armed Forces. a) <u>Visit</u>: Commemorative area, history center, 5 WWII-era buildings, equipment park, veteran's memorial plaza, sandbag filling station, marksmanship gallery, military vehicle/firetruck display; b) <u>See</u>: Demonstration of latest medical equipment, appearance by National Guard helicopter, guided installation tour (1 hour/on their bus); c) <u>Make</u>: Personalized ID tags; and much more. <u>BRING GOVERNMENT ISSUED PHOTO ID</u> as you may need to show it at the gate or to get on the narrated

There will be a "Vietnam Veterans Recognition Ceremony": 9:00 a.m.;

Breakfast for veterans and their families to follow (first come, first served).

If you served in Vietnam, let us know: a) your name, b) branch of service, c) when you were there so you can be recognized at the ceremony.

Included Lunch: "Murray's on Main," Tomah, to follow. Lunch will consist of entree (broasted chicken or beef—<u>let us know your choice when you sign up</u>), mashed potatoes, cole slaw, roll, & non-alcoholic beverage.

Tour the Dells Mill & Museum: Augusta, WI. The mill is a water-powered flour & feed mill 5

stories high built in 1864 during the American Civil War (initially used to grind wheat) & is a National landmark. It is currently owned by the Amish & has been restored to its former glory. The dam was built in 1919 and was also recently restored.



Weaver's Country Store: Fall Creek, WI. One-stop destination for natural goods, seasonal produce, bulk foods, baked items, nuts & dried fruits, meats & cheeses, organic & gluten free items, locally produced A2A2 milk & yogurt, frozen ready-to-bake bread dough, cookies, pies, pastries, kitchenware, gifts & books, vitamins, supplements, home décor accessories. They will also have hanging baskets, a food truck, and homemade ice cream.
